

Club Championship – October 2, 2011

1. Rules

The races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and SLVYRA PHRF RULES.

2. Notices To Competitors

Notices to Competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the veranda of the club.

3. Changes To Sailing Instructions

Any change to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official notice board of the club before 0930h (warning is scheduled for 1100h)

4. Marks And Starting/Finishing Line

4.1 Inflatable drop marks will be used.

4.2 The race committee boat will form one end of the starting and finishing line.

5. The Start And Class Flags

5.1 The starting line will be between the mast of the race committee boat displaying an RC flag at the starboard end of the line and the starting mark at the port end.

6. Time Limit

6.1 Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes Rule 35.

7. Protests

7.1 Protest forms are available outside the club office. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered to the bar or Protest Coordinator at the club within the time limit.

7.2 The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the race committee boat has docked after the last race of the day.

7.3 Notices will be posted on the official notice board of the club, within 10 minutes of being filed and no later than 10 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held in the board room of the club the same day.

7.4 Notices of protests by the race committee will be posted to inform boats under rule 61.1(b).

This is a qualifying event and all participants will be reminded of the event with an invitation.

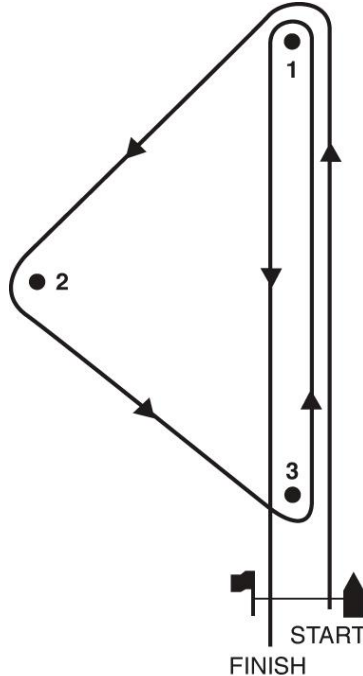
This event is open to all competitors that competed in at least one series and one of the club trophies regattas. All competitors who participate in this event will carry into the scoring for the Championship, the points scored in the 2 best events in which they participated during the season, (one series, one club trophy regatta). The score for each carried event will be their result scores in that event divided by the number of participants of the same event (i.e. 1st. place overall Tuesday series A with 10 points divided by 10 total participants in that event equals a carried-score of 1)

An eligible yacht is one that is helmed by a yachtsman in good standing of the Beaconsfield Yacht Club and a yacht that has a valid S.L.V.Y.R.A. Cruising Division handicap. The event will be sailed using the member's own boat and scored using SLVYRA handicaps, white sail or spi, used during the 2011 season.

Three (3) races will be run back to back, dropped marks will be used and the course will be a standard Gold Cup Course. (**Triangle, windward, finishing to leeward**)
