JUNIOR SAILING PROGRAMS – SUMMER 2012

THE PROGRAM:

The Junior Squadron sailing program is designed to teach the safe and proper handling of a small sailboat. Juniors are taught the theory and techniques as outlined by the C.Y.A. (Canadian Yachting Association) with as much practice time on the water as possible, weather permitting. While on the water, the juniors will be supervised by our C.Y.A approved instructors from power rescue boats. The students will be taught and tested on the C.Y.A "learn to sail" standards starting with White Sail 1 through to Bronze level V. Once the fundamentals have been mastered, the more advanced students will be introduced to small boat racing in our Silver program.

Optimist Program: Novices, Age 8 to 10 yrs

This course is a 9:00 am to 4:00pm, Monday to Friday, 2 week session.

Two-Week Sessions

Session 1 - Monday, June 25th to Friday, July 6th

Session 2 - Monday, July 9th to Friday, July 20th

Session 3 - Monday, July 23rd to Friday, August 3rd

Session 4 - Monday, August 6th to Friday, August 17th

Cost: \$370.00 / two week session

White Sail Levels I, II and III: Beginners, Ages 10 to 17yrs

This course is a 9:00am to 4:00pm, Monday to Friday, 4 week session. Students will sail our club Squadron 13's. Each student must be able to swim 50 yards while wearing a shirt, long trousers, running shoes and an approved life jacket.

Four-Week Sessions

Session 1 – Monday, June 25th to Friday, July 20th

Session 2 - Monday, July 23rd to Friday, August 17th

Cost: \$640.00 / four week session

Bronze Level IV and V: Intermediates, Ages 10 to 17yrs

This course is a 9:00am to 4:00pm, Monday to Friday, 4 week session. Students will sail our club 420's and Laser II's. Each student must be able to swim 50 yards while wearing a shirt, long trousers, running shoes and an approved life jacket.

Four-Week Sessions

Session 1 – Monday, June 25th to Friday, July 20th

Session 2 - Monday, July 23rd to Friday, August 17th

Cost: \$640.00 / four week session

Advanced Racing and Tactics Program (C.Y.A. Silver Level VI)

For intermediate sailors who have completed their Bronze V level, we offer the "Advanced Racing and Tactics Program" (C.Y.A. Silver Level VI), course using BYC's 420's. For more information on this course please contact the B.Y.C. office.

REFUND & CANCELLATION POLICY: An administration fee of **\$50.00** will be charged for all cancellations received later than **May 25th, 2012**. There will be no refund after the start of classes which is June 25th, 2012.

CLOTHING AND SAFETY GEAR: Students must wear soft-soled shoes, and bring their own **MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT** approved Personal Flotation Device. (P.F.D.) Water ski vests, belts, and air cell jackets are **NOT** acceptable. The student will not be permitted on the water if the safety equipment does not meet the approval of the Club Manager.

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION: Courses are conducted primarily in English; however our instructors are bilingual and will assist any student in either of Canada's official languages.
