ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP 2012

This membership is called an Associate Membership and includes the following:

1. Who can be an Associate Member?

Anyone interested in sailing or boating over the age of 30 years in January of the year of application.

2. Why over 30 years old?

Because an individual under 30 years shall be an Intermediate member paying still lower fees.

3. What does an Associate Membership cost?

The annual fee for Associate Membership for the year 2012 shall be \$344. An associate member over 65 years old will pay \$172. All Beaconsfield residents will receive a 15% reduction in associate membership fees which would be \$292 or \$146 for those over 65 years of age.

4. What do you get for these fees? - Membership in one of the premier Yacht Clubs on Lac St. Louis.

- a. All privileges available to senior members with the exception of voting rights. (Club By-Laws are specific that only senior members in good standing may vote).
- b. Use of the Club training boats outside regularly scheduled programs.
- c. Membership includes your spouse and children.

5. What about hidden fees / costs?

There are none – except for what you spend at our Bar and canteen where there is a minimum charge of \$180.00 annually. This is easily met by charging your meals, and drink purchases to your club account from May to the end of September. Special event fees also are applied to this amount with the exception of the “Commodores Ball”.

6. When does an Associate Membership finish?

If and when you purchase a boat and request mooring, dock or dry sail facilities, your membership status will then change. You will then become a Senior member and pay regular Senior membership fees, however depending upon the time you have been an Associate Member your savings can be quite substantial.

7. What are the substantial savings?

If you joined the yacht club with a boat today you would have to pay full Senior membership plus an Entrance Fee – currently \$850.00. As an Associate Member this Entrance Fee is rebated at the rate of 20% per annum, so if you are an Associate Member for five (5) years you will pay no Entrance fee.
