**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

**2 ADVERTISING**

Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

**3\* ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all members of the ILCA.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at registration, together with the required fee.

**5 FEES**

- 5.1 The cost of registration is \$125 CAD, payable in complete during registration, by cheque or cash only.

**6 SCHEDULE**

**6.1** Registration:

Saturday July 3	From 8 AM	To 9 AM

**6.2** Dates of racing:

Saturday July 3	racing	11 AM
Sunday July 4	racing	10 AM

**6.3** The championship will consist of 7 races.

**6.4** No warning signal shall be made after 14:30 on Sunday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

**7 MEASUREMENTS**

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

**9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

**10 VENUE**

**10.1** The event will be hosted by the Beaconsfield YC, located at 26 Lakeshore Rd, Beaconsfield, QC, H9W 4H3. Racing will take place on Lake St Louis, South of the BYC harbour.

**11 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**11.1** Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

**12 SCORING**

**12.1** The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

**12.2** 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 12.3**
- (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
  - (b) When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**14 BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park. Boats shall use the cranes provided by the Organizing Authority.

**15 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. The Race Committee will attempt to broadcast over early starts over VHF on channel 77.

**16 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>.

**17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**18 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,000,000.00 CAD per event or the equivalent.
