ORGANIZING AUTHORITY BEACONSFIELD YACHT CLUB

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as they may be amended by this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES

- 2.1. Entry is restricted to youth sailors born January 1, 1992 or later. Proof of age is required. Contact administration@byc.qc.ca attn: FACTR or call 514-695-1272 with any questions regarding eligibility.
- 2.2. The regatta will be limited to club 420 boats which will be shared between competitors (Not all outside clubs are not expected to bring boats).

3. FEES

- 3.1. Entries and payment are due on or before July 14th, 2008. The entry fee includes: 2 days of racing, a Regatta souvenir, a BBQ on Monday night and prizes for the top 3 boats (note no lunches will be provided).
- 3.2. **The entry fee is \$40 per competitor. ONLY CASH OR CHEQUE ACCEPTED.**

4.2. The Final Regatta Schedule will be available at registration check in. A copy will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

5. REGISTRATION

- 5.1. No registration will be accepted after 0900 on Monday, August 9th , 2010.
5.2. Registration for racing will be accepted as drop-off at Beaconsfield Yacht Club before Monday, August 9th , 2010 as well as on the morning of.

6. MEASUREMENT

- 6.1. During competition boats may be subject to inspection.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1. The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

8. VENUE

- 8.1. Race Areas will be on Lake St- Louis, adjacent to the Beaconsfield Yacht Club.

9. THE COURSES

- 9.1. The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

- 10.1. The access of coach and support boats will be restricted. Coach and support boat drivers shall register at the registration desk and on race days shall check in with the race committee on water.

11. BERTHING

- 11.1. Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

- 13.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance covering an adequate amount.

14. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 14.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the Clubhouse veranda.
