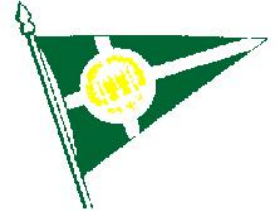

## NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### 2010 - TROPHY RACES - 2010

Trophy races are held annually at BYC and offer an opportunity for those, who don't normally race, to get out on the water and sails around some marks and have some fun. It is also another chance for the hardened racers to go head to head.

#### JURISDICTION

These races shall be sailed under the management of the Beaconsfield Yacht Club Race Committee.

## REGISTRATION AND ELIGIBILITY

An eligible yacht is one that is helmed by a yachtsman in good standing with a recognized SLVYRA Yacht Club. Yachts without SLYRA handicaps will be assigned one by the Race Committee.

Yachts are encouraged to register by returning the attached form to the Beaconsfield Yacht Club administration office, 26 Lakeshore Road, Beaconsfield. The closing time for entry registration is 5:00 pm on the Friday before the race. Eligible boats may also register on the day of the race by sailing on starboard tack past the Race Committee boat and hailing their boat's sail number and boat type and , when applicable, white sail or spinnaker.

## RULES

The following rules will apply:

1. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2009 - 12 and the prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association, will govern all Races except as are changed by these sailing instructions.
2. The S.L.V.Y.R.A. handicap rules.
3. All yachts shall have their correct sail numbers displayed on their mainsail and genoa in order to be scored, unless the Race Committee is advised in writing of the discrepancy before the registration deadline. (The information can be included in the registration form for the race)

## RACE AREA

The race will be held off BYC on Lake St Louis.

## CHANGES IN SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change in the sailing instructions will be posted on the Bulletin board at BYC at least one hour before the start of the race.

## LIABILITY

The organizing authority is not responsible for any damage or injury either ashore or afloat, either to persons or yachts, which might result from participating in the race.

## **COURSES AND MARKS**

SLVYRA marks will be in use except for the Pursuit Race. For the Commodore's Bowl, **One** of three courses will be selected according to the wind direction and a flag indicating which course has been selected will be flown on the mast of the committee boat prior to the warning gun.

## **TIME LIMITS AND ABANDONED RACES**

There will be no re-sails.

The Race Committee may, at its discretion, shorten or abandon the race.

There will be a time limit of one (1) hour after the first yacht to finish. In order to avoid an unnecessary search, any boat abandoning shall inform either the RC boat on the water or BYC at 514-695-1272 as soon as possible.

## **PROTESTS**

Protests must be filled on CYA forms available at the BYC clubhouse in accordance with the Rules, and submitted to the Race Committee within 30 minutes of its arrival on shore. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after the expiry of the 30-minute time limit.

## **SCORING AND PRIZES**

The prizes will be awarded based on the best overall handicap finish.

The Trophies will be presented at the annual year-end "Awards Night."

**Note** - Scoring and prizes for the Turkey Bowl

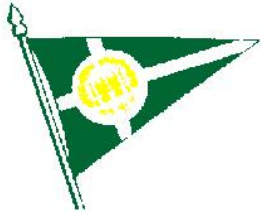
Prizes to be awarded for this regatta will be turkeys; the number of prizes being determined by the number of entries.

Scoring for the draw for prizes shall be as follows:

<b>Placing</b>	<b>Draw Tickets</b>
1st place	Number of starters plus 2
2nd place	Number of starters
3rd place	Number of starters minus 1
4th place	Number of starters minus 2
Etc ..... etc .....etc .....	Etc ..... etc .....etc .....
DNF	Two draws
DNS, DSQ	One draw

The drawing for prizes shall take place as soon as possible after the race and after any protests have been heard, in the main Club House of the Beaconsfield Yacht Club. An entrant, upon winning a prize, shall not be eligible for further prizes.

In the event that the race is not started, or is abandoned, a drawing shall award the prizes, with one draw per entrant.

Course 1 (Westerly Wind)	Red	<p><b>Start:</b> Between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on <b>the Committee Boat</b> on the starboard end and <b>mark 33</b> on the port end of the line.            Leave mark 34 to port, mark 44 to port, mark 42 to port and mark 32 to port.  <b>Finish:</b> Between the mast displaying the R.C. flag <b>the Committee boat</b> to Starboard and <b>mark 33</b> to port.</p>
Course 2 (Southerly Wind)	Green	<p><b>Start:</b> Between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on <b>the Committee Boat</b> on the starboard end and <b>mark 33</b> on the port end of the line.            Leave mark 44 to port, mark 42 to port, mark 32 to port.  <b>Finish</b> between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on the Committee Boat at the starboard end and mark 33 to port.</p>
Course 3 (Easterly Wind)	Purple	<p><b>Start:</b> Between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on <b>the Committee Boat</b> on the starboard end and <b>mark 33</b> on the port end of the line.            Leave mark 31 to port, leave mark 33 to port, leave mark 34 to port.  <b>Finish</b> between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on the Committee Boat at the port end of the line and mark 33 to starboard.</p>

Long Distance Race
<p><b>Start:</b> Between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on the mast displaying the R.C. flag on <b>the Committee Boat</b> on the starboard end and <b>mark 33</b> on the port end of the line.  <b>Leave 18 to port. Leave 31 to port.</b>  <b>Finish</b> between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on the Committee boat at the starboard end of the finishing line and <b>mark 33</b> at the port end.  <b>Shortened Course:</b> In the event that the race is <b>shortened mark 31</b> will be omitted and the finish will be between the Committee Boat at the port end of the line and <b>mark 33</b> at the starboard end.</p>

Pursuit Race (Dropped marks will be used)
<p><b>Start:</b> Between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on the mast displaying the R.C. flag on <b>the Committee Boat</b> on the starboard end and <b>mark 33</b> on the port end of the line.</p>
<p><b>Leave</b> the windward mark to port, the jibe mark to port, mark 33 to port, the windward mark to port,</p>
<p><b>Finish</b> between the mast displaying the R.C. flag on the Committee boat at the starboard end of the finishing line and <b>mark 33</b> at the port end.</p>
