## Notice of Race

### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The event will be a qualifier for the Canada Summer Games.
- 1.3 Federal, Provincial and Municipal regulations relating to COVID-19 shall apply.
- 1.4 Appendix P of the RRS will apply.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the French text takes precedence.

### 2 Sailing Instructions

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available online at <https://www.byc.qc.ca/fr/voile/courses/>.

### 3 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The event is open to ILCA 4, 6, and 7. (Laser 4.7, Laser radial, and Laser Standard)
- 3.2 The event is open to members in good standing of the International Laser Class Association (ILCA). Applications for membership can be made directly at <https://laser.org/about-joining>.
- 3.3 The event is open to members in good standing of a sailing club affiliated with the Federation de Voile du Quebec or Sail Canada.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and submitting it online before 23h59 on May 25 at: <https://forms.gle/QDTdGQ86shivpuoD9>. There will be no registration on site at the club. The fee must be paid before the registration deadline by Interac etransfer to [administration@byc.qc.ca](mailto:administration@byc.qc.ca). The password is IBM2022.
- 3.5 Boats shall sail with the sail number used at registration. (DP)

3.6 Boats shall sail with the same rig (ILCA 4 or 6 or 7) for all races in the regatta. (DP)

#### **4 Fees**

4.1 The entry fee is \$60.00 which includes taxes and a dinner for competitors on Saturday, May 28 after racing.

#### **5 Schedule**

5.1 Saturday May 28th.

Skippers meeting 09h00

First warning signal 10h00

Sunday May 29th

First warning signal 10h00

5.2 The ILCA 4, 6, and 7 classes will start together.

5.3 Eight races are scheduled.

5.4 No warning signal will be made after 15h00 on the final day of the regatta.

#### **6 Courses**

6.1 The courses will be provided with the Sailing Instructions.

6.2 The racing area will be south of the Beaconsfield Yacht Club Harbour.

#### **7 Scoring**

7.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

7.2 (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

This changes A2.

#### **8 Prizes**

8.1 Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each of the ILCA 4, 6, and 7 fleets.

Additional prizes may be awarded based upon the number of competitors in each fleet.

8.2 The Ian Bruce Memorial perpetual trophy will be awarded to the top master sailor.

#### **9 Support Boats**

9.1 A support boat shall register online. There is no registration fee for a support boat.

9.2 Support boats shall carry a raised and visible pennant.

#### **10 Risk Statement**

10.1 Athletes are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility (see RRS 3, Decision to Race). It is for athletes to decide whether their boat is fit to sail in the conditions in which it will find itself. By launching or going

to sea athletes confirm the boat is fit for those conditions and they are competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organizers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or athletes, nor will it make the organizers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organizers encompass everyone helping to run the event. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and athletes of their responsibilities.

### **11 Assurance**

Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate third-party liability insurance.

### **12 PHOTO AND VIDEO DISCLAIMER**

By participating in the event, competitors give absolute right and permission for any photograph and video footage taken of themselves or the boat they are sailing during the event to be published in any media whatsoever, for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information without compensation.

### **13 Additional Useful Information**

#### **Parking**

In order to avoid overcrowding and to respect social distancing, the lower parking area will be reserved for competitors only. Support persons shall use the upper parking area.

**No food or water** will be provided to competitors on the water.
